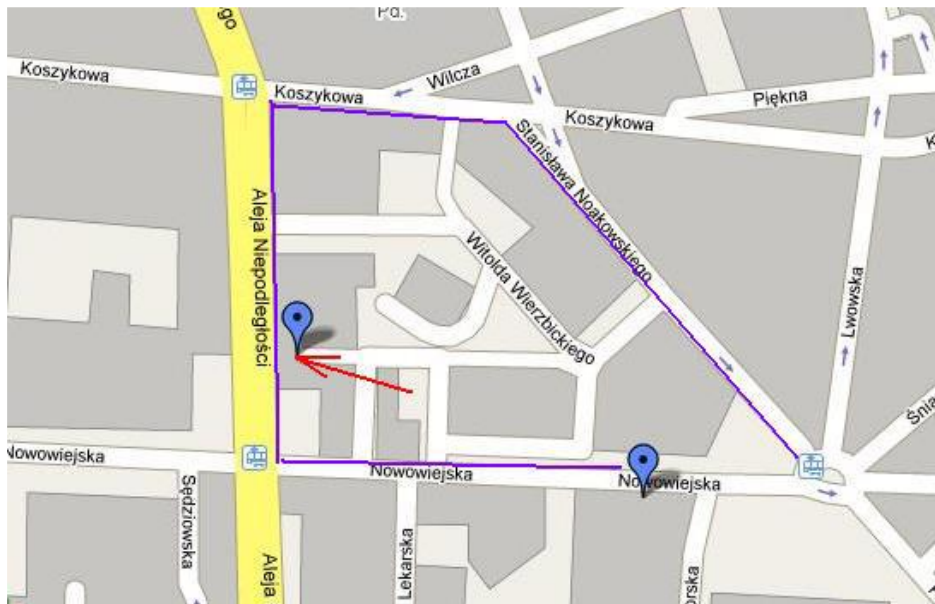

3.Location of the Faculty and Deanery

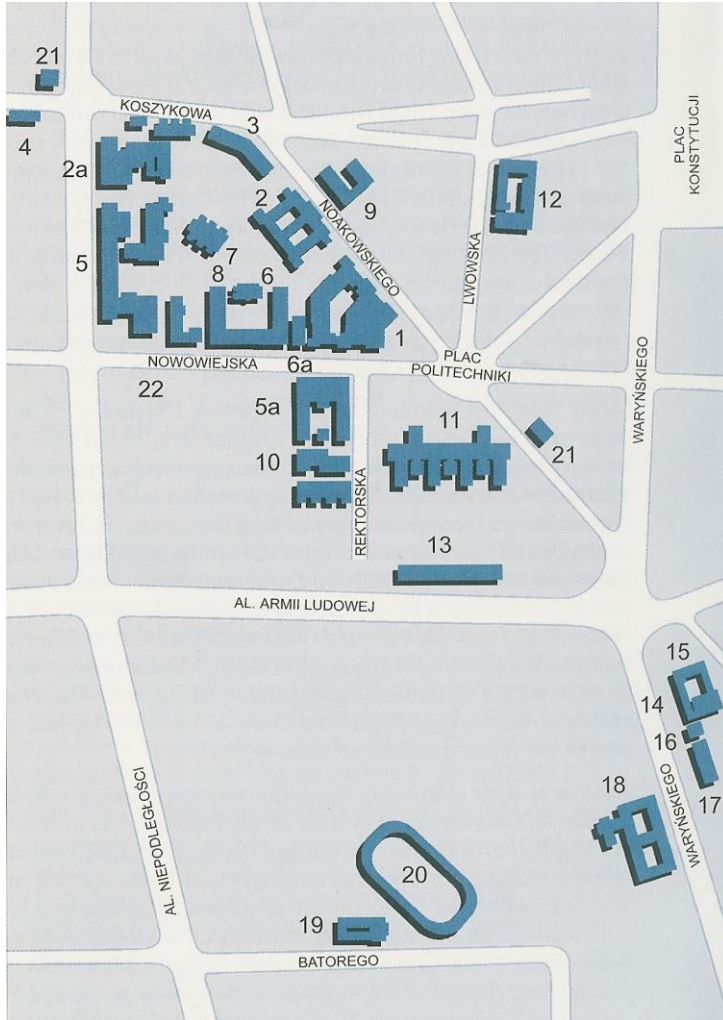

Warsaw (Polish: *Warszawa* [var'ʂava] is the capital and largest city of Poland. It is located on the Vistula River roughly 370 kilometers (230 mi) from both the Baltic Sea coast and the Carpathian Mountains. Its population as of 2007 was estimated at 1,706,624, with a metropolitan area of approximately 2,785,000

Warsaw University of Technology (WUT) founded in 1826 is a research intensive academic institution focused on undergraduate and graduate programs in engineering and applied sciences. It is the largest one from all Polish technical universities. WUT is the highest ranking engineering university in Poland (www.pw.edu.pl)

Poland

Poland is located in heart of Europe where East meets West. If you are interested in culture and history you will find here many interesting places. If you like landscape, trekking or other outdoor activities you will be glad too. Poland's territory extends across several geographical regions. The country spreads from the Baltic Sea in the north, through the lakes and deep forests to the hills, rocks and the mountains with walking routes, and adventure hiking areas in the very south. Poland has 21 mountains over 2,000 metres (6,600 ft) in elevation, all in the High Tatras. With almost ten thousand closed bodies of water covering more than one hectare (2.47 acres) each, the country has one of the highest numbers of lakes in the world.

This country is quite recent member of EU (since 2004), has a long tradition in education (one of the first European universities was created in Poland). Comparing to the other EU members the living expenses and educational costs in Poland are still lower.

14. The weather

The climate has four seasons; green spring, gold and sunny summer, red and yellow autumn, and snowy, white winter. The climate is more oceanic in the north and west and becomes gradually warmer and continental as one moves south and east. Summers are generally warm, with average temperatures between 20 °C (68 °F) and 27 °C (81 °F). Winters are cold, with average temperatures around 3 °C (37 °F) in the northwest and -8 °C (17.6 °F) in the northeast.

If you are a student registered at other Warsaw University of Technology faculty, you should do the following things to attend the classes organized at Faculty of Power and Aeronautical Engineering:

1. You should check the Faculty timetable available here and write the course codes and names of the subjects:

Usually the subjects from the Bachelor programme are in semesters 1,3,5,7 in winter semester

and 2,4,6 in summer semester.

 - a. The lecturer’s of the chosen subjects

 - c. The Dean of Faculty of Power and Aeronautical Engineering Prof. Maciej Jaworski

The form should be indicated to the Dean Prof. Maciej Jaworski

Only the Dean can decide if you are going to attend the classes or not.
