Building: (engineering & architectural)

A physical object that is used for certain type of production function by society.

Production:


Activities to produce goods and services.

Construction:

Production of buildings on site or at factory.

System:

An event, entity, object or concept that is formed by interrelated components.



Building system:

The physical structure of the building that is formed by load-bearing, heating, lighting, envelop, partitioning, sanitary etc. interrelated sub-sytems (components).

Production system:

The pattern that is formed by the structure, participants, and the inputs of the *production process*.

Building production system:

The pattern that is formed by the structure, participants, and the inputs of the *building* production process.

Building construction system:

Technology that is used to produce the building.

Building Construction Systems

Technologies that are used for the production of buildings in <u>construction stage</u>. **Building Production Systems**

Patterns that are applied to building production in <u>all stages</u> of Building Production Process.

Building Construction Systems (BCS)

- On-site construction systems.
- Prefabricated construction systems.
- Conctruction systems based on Rationalized Formwork Systems (RFS). (climbing formworks, moving formworks, sliding formworks, filigrane formworks, travelling formworks).

Building Production Systems (BPS)

• Building Production Process (BPP).

(pre-design, design, bidding, tendering, contracting, construction, maintenance, demolishing).

• The structure of the BPP.


(accelerated: fast-track or traditional process).

• The participants in BPP; their roles and relationships, organizational patterns




Participants & Roles (Design-Build)




Participants & Roles (Separate Trades)
